Between Omnipotence and Powerlessness: Religious symbolizations and theological interpretations of power

The paper will explain the thesis that "religion" is a form of communication about the generation, distribution and legitimation of power. It will explain features of the "moral ontology" of the christian patterns of interpretation that are centered around concepts like "charisma" and "love" and will look at the consequences for the understanding of political power and human agency.
